

## **Review: "Lemonade" Album: Sunny Side**

“Lemonade” is a relaxing acoustic ballad about always being grateful for the life you live, despite what seemingly difficult situations might be thrown at you.

Musically, this is a very stripped down, basic country song, with only an acoustic guitar and a glimmering subtle synth hook on the choruses. This provides the perfect backdrop for the lyrical message to take centre stage without any distractions.

This was a very smart decision by Andrew Neil as, in a time where people seem to have nothing better to do than to complain about things, songs with an optimistic message like this one is all the more rare and ever more important.

I have briefly touched on the synth hook in the chorus, but I must come back to it again as it’s quite simply masterful. You think you know the song musically and then out of nowhere this synth comes in to keep you on your toes.

I would argue this simple synth line that keeps reoccurring in the choruses is perhaps the catchiest part of this song, and it will certainly be in my head for a while.
