Peter Lake is one of the few Indies I approached about promotion.

I heard his song and was flashed back to one of the best music groups in history, The Bee Gees.

He really has some Robin Gibb vocal similarities - that angelic register that delivers dark and light with the tones that always hurts so good.

He owns his own sound, but that flashback was utter bliss for me and I'm not letting him go!

The harmonies have Bee Gees level greatness, both in technique and feel. There are so many Genres thrown about, what's wrong with 60s/70s alike Classic Rock with lite anthemic.

I think there may be pond-ping pong reinvasions of old school R & R going on. Many USA and English Bands are going back in time to bring the best 60s/70s Rock forward to these volatile modern times.

Cool thing, Indie Bands do this in distinctive ways. Peter Lake is ultra-distinctive!

The song writing is superior. Peter doesn't force the rhyme, perfect fits; what I call, "Oasis Rhyming." His message is clear, and he is an unrestrained thinker and creator. The Team Reviewers spill all of the great music analysis.

What stands out to me is how perfectly the instrumentation and melody meet the vocal. This allows for a clear and impactful delivery that trips into the hypnotic.
