Katie Ware uses her strong register, pitch and amazing voice for a splendid delivery of well written lyrics that swim in fear, darkness and pain. We would think such a lovely voice wouldn't pull a listener into her abyss; how wrong, she drowns us!

Katie began in opera- I was not surprised to learn this. I had commented elsewhere that I could feel her ability to burst out vocally! She uses vocal reins, as it were, to control and modulate such capability into exacting anthemic delivery.

Many singers have technique; Katie Ware is loaded with it and lives it with true passion and conviction.

Everything about her performance in the video reeks of this commitment, as well as her familiarity with the song.
