Wild Horse never put reins on imagination and this video reeks the creative benefits of being so wide open! Great 80s retro- the karaoke coin up top, breakdancing, pacman types of games on the modern and the cinematography has a vintage burn and contemporary flare!

I dubbed this tune, when I first heard it, with a New Edition vibe, a great R&B/Pop/Funk Band that popped in the 80s. This is a funky/pop song that earns a Jackson 5 tag, "It's a Dancing Machine!" From me, a huge compliment.
