

"Symphony of Broken Hearts" - Wild Horse

So much of making a new track is adding to it!

Most tracks now have a huge sound; the bigger the better, double track the guitar, add a second, add a backline, double it, overlay it an octave up!

Now more than ever, producing a stripped back minimalist track is a risk. It takes courage and massive confidence in your vocals and in the core of your song idea

With their brand new single, "Symphony Of Broken Hearts," Wild Horse have taken that risk and it has paid off in spades!

Opening almost acapella with only drums accompanying for the first few bars, the minimalist piano kicks in softly to gently lift Jack's voice while allowing it to dominate.

Dealing with lost love, the lyrics and vibe draw you in before the pre chorus builds and vocal harmonies kick in for the chorus.

The dynamics and range of the vocals help this stripped back, minimalist track sound epic.

The track ends all too soon, feeling the loss it describes and this shall earn a lot of repeat listens.

I'm already a fan of Wild Horse and, "Symphony Of Broken Hearts," is an awesome addition to their catalogue. Different but still carrying their signature-minimalist but huge.
